CELEBRATING AT HOME

Outdoor activities are preferred over indoor activities,  but the virus can still spread outdoors.

CONSIDER YOUR SPACE

When inviting people over or going to another person's gathering, **consider the available space.**

Only host or attend events where guests have

space to social distance.



SHARED RESPONSIBILITY

If anyone in your household does not feel well,

CANCEL THE GATHERING.



**Remind guests to stay home
if they do not feel well.**



Safe Hosting Practices



Discourage people from **gathering in groups**



Keep a **list of guests** in case it is needed for contact tracing



Ensure guests can practice **proper hand hygiene** (have soap and water and/or hand sanitizer available)



Limit the use of **shared items** (e.g. use single-use towels instead of a shared hand towel)



Consider providing **cleaning supplies** for guests to wipe down and sanitize shared surfaces (e.g. sink handles, door handles, bathrooms)

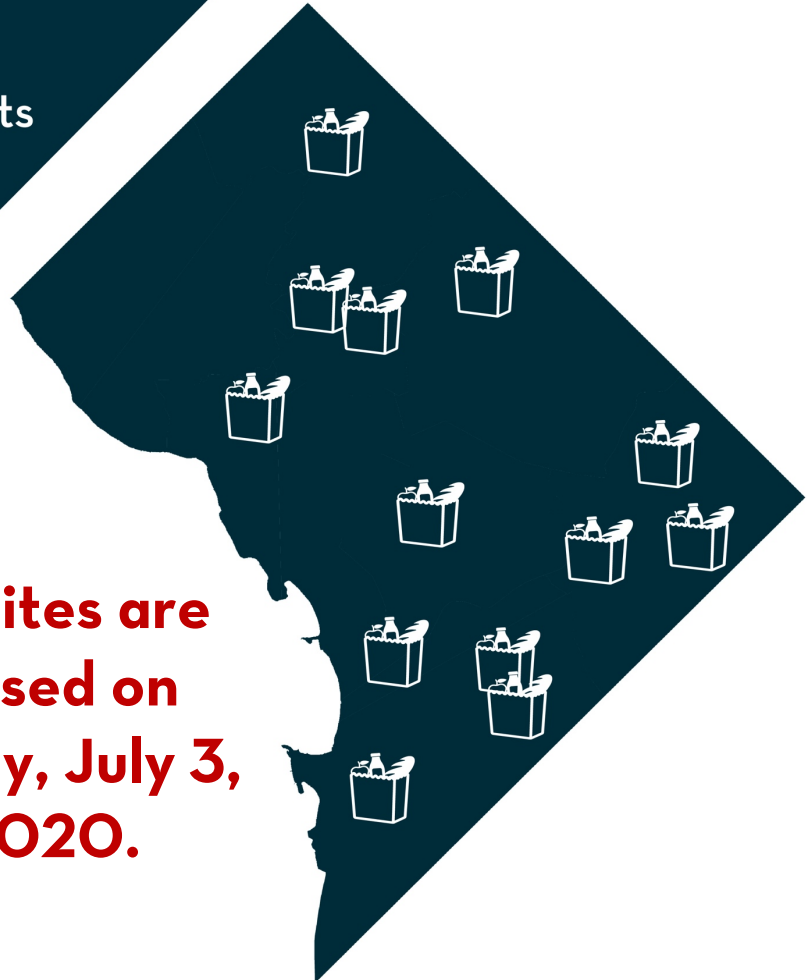
