

Honoring DC Veterans 2015

Veterans Day originated as "Armistice Day" on Nov. 11, 1919, the first anniversary marking the end of World War I. Congress passed a resolution in 1926 for an annual observance, and Nov. 11 became a national holiday beginning in 1938. President Dwight Eisenhower signed legislation in 1954 to change the name to Veterans Day as a way to honor those who served in all American wars. The day honors military veterans with parades and speeches across the nation. A national ceremony takes place at the Tomb of the Unknowns at Arlington National Cemetery in Arlington, Va. As of 2014 the District of Columbia had 28,055 veterans.



Total living veterans in the District of Columbia 2014: **28,055**




DC's Veterans by Race and Ethnicity: 2014





Veteran: male **\$47,945**


Veteran: female **\$68,906**

The individual median income for DC's non-veterans was **\$40,130**


Non-veteran: male **\$44,406**

Non-veteran: female **\$34,341**


DC's Veterans by Educational Attainment
